Camarillo CROP Hunger Walk

Accomplishments:

In 2024, the Camarillo CROP Hunger Walk raised over \$33,000! Of this, \$8,254 went to local charities. Since 1984 Camarillo CROP walk has raised over \$694,600, with over \$173,600 supporting local hunger-fighting efforts. 75% of the funds support Church World Service, a faith-based organization, providing sustainable hunger, responses to poverty, displacement, and disaster. Church World Service emphasizes grassroots development projects and interfaith collaboration.

2025 Funds Destinations:

25% will go locally to St. Columba's Episcopal Church Food Pantry, St. Mary Magdalen Christian Service Program, Christians Acting Together, and RAIN Transitional Living Center.

75% will support programs throughout the world to provide developmental assistance, to give aid for emergencies, and to sponsor educational projects.
